**Houston Executive Airport Announces Completion of  
Corporate FBO Hangar  
*26,000 Sq. Ft. Hangar Ready for Occupancy***

BROOKSHIRE -- (February 6, 2008) – Houston Executive Airport (HEA) has announced the completion of a 26,000 sq. ft. corporate hangar. This is the first phase of construction for the airport's terminal building, Henriksen Jet Center.

The announcement was made by HEA owner and developer, Ron Henriksen. "Houston Executive Airport was built specifically to meet the needs of corporate travelers to Houston," said Henriksen. "The completion of our corporate hangar is part of our mission to provide an outstanding general aviation airport for an ever-growing business community, here in Houston and beyond."

Located at 1900 Cardiff Road in Brookshire in an area of rapid growth and business development, HEA is a private commercial development established by a former commercial pilot and Houston native, Ron Henriksen. HEA will cater to business and general aviation aircraft. With an eye for coming growth, Henriksen has long-range plans for the airport's runway to be extended to 7,604 feet to accommodate larger aircraft.

The 26,000 sq. ft. hangar includes a maintenance bay and is large enough to house two Gulfstream 550's. "We have already received a number of calls about leasing the hangar," said Henriksen. "Our location along Houston's energy corridor and close proximity to Interstate 10 makes HEA a great, convenient choice for those doing business in Houston."

HEA opened 20 T-Hangars to tenants November 1, 2007, which are completely occupied. HEA reported that many hangars were leased in advance of construction.

After more than 2 years of planning and construction, Houston Executive Airport (HEA) opened for business in January 2007. The second phase of construction currently underway is the airport's Runway extension to 6,610 feet. The runway extension is scheduled for completion in March 2008.

HEA Executive Director Andrew D. Perry, A.A.E., said the airport will provide first-class amenities including 24-hour aircraft fueling, ground handling operations, rental and crew cars, crew lounge, catering services and complimentary wireless internet access. Chevron Global Aviation was named the airport's fuel supplier. "We are poised to provide premium service for the business air traveler visiting West Houston," Perry said.
