NEW NAME AND NEW FACES FOR NEW HOUSTON AIRPORT

(Near Houston, Texas – April 8, 2006) Airport developer WCF, LLC has announced that Houston Executive Airport is the new permanent name for the airport it is building just west of Houston, and has hired an industry veteran to manage the new facility.

WCF principal Ron Henriksen explained, “the new name more accurately describes the location and purpose of the airport. Houston is growing and the most aggressive business growth is on the west side of town. The airport is designed to serve that kind of growth in Houston.” Much of Houston’s business aviation traffic operates out of the increasingly congested air carrier airports, William P. Hobby and George Bush Intercontinental Airport. Just as the Collin County Regional Airport in McKinney has become a business aviation center for companies doing business in Plano and Dallas, Houston Executive Airport is designed to provide a gateway to the west side of Houston for companies currently forced to use the air carrier airports.

Henriksen also announced that WCF has hired Andrew Perry, A.A.E., as the Executive Director of Houston Executive Airport. “We are delighted to have Andy join our team,” Henriksen stated. “We interviewed highly qualified people from around the country and Andy was our first choice.” Perry was the aviation director for Dubuque, Iowa, and has managed airports in Kansas and Missouri. He is a member of the American Association of Airport Executives.

Henriksen also named project spokesman Drew Coats as the Director of Civic and Governmental Affairs and General Counsel for Houston Executive Airport. Coats remains a shareholder in the aviation law firm, Coats & Evans, P.C.

Construction began on Houston Executive Airport, previously called the South Waller County Airport, late last year. After months of site and drainage work, the first concrete for the new airport was poured on March 10, 2006. Construction on the new airport remains well ahead of schedule.
